

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Thermopolis Town Council met in regular session October 18, 2022, at 7 pm at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Mike Chimenti, Council members Tony Larson, John Dorman Sr., Bill Malloy, and Dusty Lewis. Also, present were Mayor/Codes Administrative Assistant Fred Crosby, Clerk/Treasurer Tracey Van Heule, Police Chief Pat Cornwell, Town Engineer Anthony Barnette and Town Attorney Mike Messenger.

AGENDA: Following the pledge of allegiance, Larson made a motion, seconded by Malloy and carried to approve the agenda as written.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Malloy made a motion, seconded by Dorman and carried to approve the financial statement for September 2022.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION: None.

TOWN ENGINEER: ANTHONY BARNETT: Barnett noted the final payment on the Silo project was advertised. He also updated the Mayor and Council on the Fremont/Peppermint Street water/sewer line replacement project.

TOWN ATTORNEY: MIKE MESSENGER: Nothing currently.

ADMINISTRATION: FRED CROSBY: LOT SPLIT-REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT: Crosby reviewed a memo from Overfield on moving the lot line for 206 S. 4th Street. A map was provided with details of the lot split. Crosby recommended approval of the lot split with provisions for a 20' utility access. Lewis made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to allow the east/west lot split with a north/south utility easement. He also noted there are portions of current structures in the Town's alley. A right-of-way agreement was provided for approval. Lewis made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to approve the right-of-way agreement.

ADMINISTRATION: UPDATES: Chief Cornwell noted the Town had received two grants, one for \$2,500 for impaired driving and the other for \$1,500 for seat belts. He is also reviewing a grant for emergency medical training and software for dispatch.

MAYOR & COUNCIL: OTHER: Chimenti noted the City of Cody is asking for funds to help with the WAM Convention in June of 2023. Malloy made a motion, seconded by Larson and carried to pay \$1,000 for a WAM convention sponsorship. The meeting adjourned at 7:17 pm and the next Council meeting is November 1, 2022, at 7pm.
